An Interdisciplinary Acupuncture Education

Offered in both **Copenhagen and Holstebro**, this program bridges Eastern and Western medicine through an in-depth understanding of functional anatomy, enabling physicians and acupuncturists to communicate in a shared clinical language.

The training is taught at a bachelor-equivalent level, aligned with the national qualification framework for private education.

Modular Structure of the Training

The program consists of **18 modules**, scheduled monthly as follows:

Thursday: 15:00 – 21:30Friday: 09:00 – 18:00

Each module is supplemented by 10 engaging e-learning lessons in Classical Chinese Acupuncture, which students complete remotely from home.

The training is officially approved as a 3-year program, though the lessons are delivered over the first two years, during which exams can be completed. The third year is dedicated to clinical practice, requiring 30 hours at a clinic of your choice. Additionally, students work one-on-one with Anne Marie on a personal project aimed at enabling communication with a broad audience, ensuring that all educational materials developed for clients are of a high academic standard and validity.

Payment Terms

- **Deposit:** 10,000 DKK due after enrolment, upon which e-learning access is granted.
- The remaining balance can be paid in 10 to 20 monthly instalments, arranged by agreement.
- If your employer covers the training costs, the instalments are deducted from your gross salary, which will reduce your taxable income, effectively lowering the financial impact by approximately half of the tuition fee.

If you have already completed these subjects as part of a previous education, they do not need to be repeated.

Tongue Diagnosis

Students are guaranteed to master tongue diagnosis and learn to apply it to both well-known and less commonly described imbalances and diseases.

Facial Diagnosis

Students will master facial diagnosis, enabling them to identify both inherited tendencies to illness and imbalances caused by lifestyle factors.

Classical Acupuncture

We guarantee that all students can confidently apply Classical Acupuncture and understand its physiological and philosophical foundations, based on the physical laws of the universe, across multiple dimensions:
